Cambodian Water Supply Association (CWA) is a Neutral Association, non-profit, non racism, non religion and non political and non political affiliate organization that brings together all private water operators in Cambodia and acts in the interest of the members of the Association.

CWA was established on December 28, 2011, and officially registered with the Ministry of Interior (Mol) on August 6, 2012 and re-registered as a Legal Entity Association on November 8, 2021 with the Ministry of Interior (Mol). As of quarter 3 2025, CWA has 342 members of which 286 are licensed private water operators, operating in 23 provinces.

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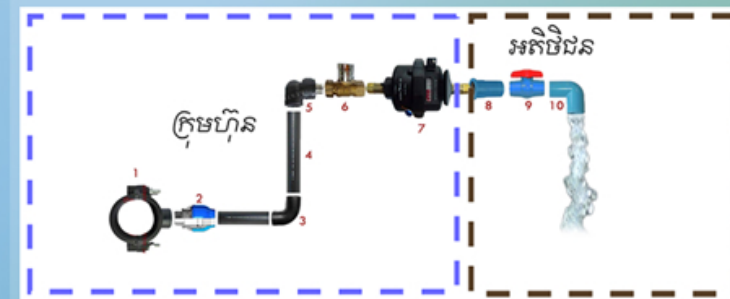
